

VAPING & NICOTINE INITIATIVE

2023-2024

The Monroe County high School and Middle School Student Prevention Leadership Teams (SPLT) organize and conduct an annual Vaping and Nicotine Initiative focused on educating their peers about the risks associated with vaping and nicotine use.

96% Monroe County High School and Middle School Students surveyed acknowledged that **most Vaping products contain nicotine** and put them at risk for nicotine dependence.

93% Monroe County High School and Middle School students surveyed were able to identify **healthy ways to cope with stress and anxiety** without having to vape

90% Monroe County High School and Middle School students surveyed were able to **identify at least 3 risks & consequences** associated with vaping.

95% Monroe County High School and Middle School students surveyed were able to **identify at least 3 refusal skills** relating to tobacco/nicotine.
